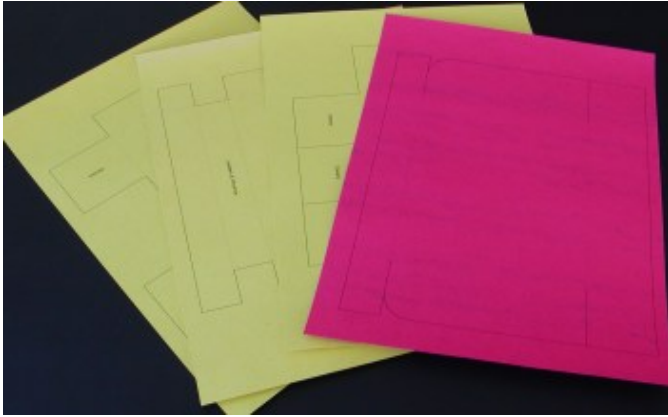


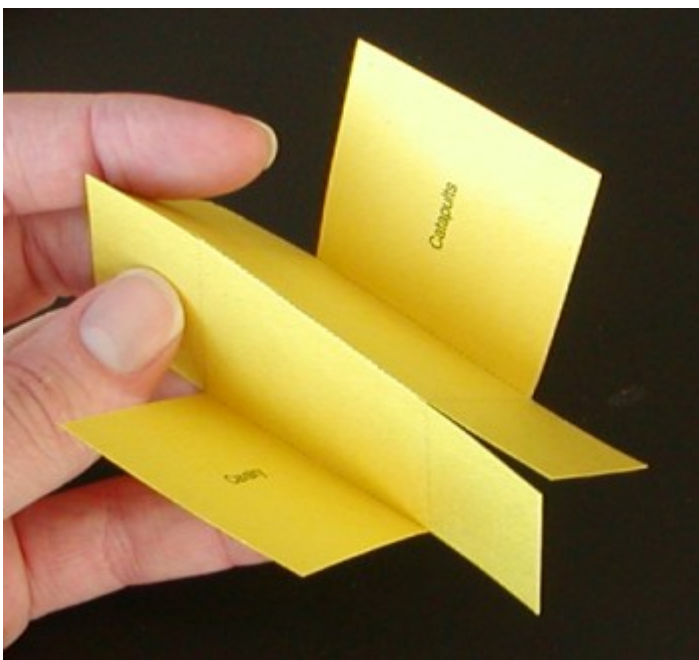
Conquest Of The Empire II – Organizers



1st page is the outer shell of the box;
the other three pages will form the dividers &
interior of the box.



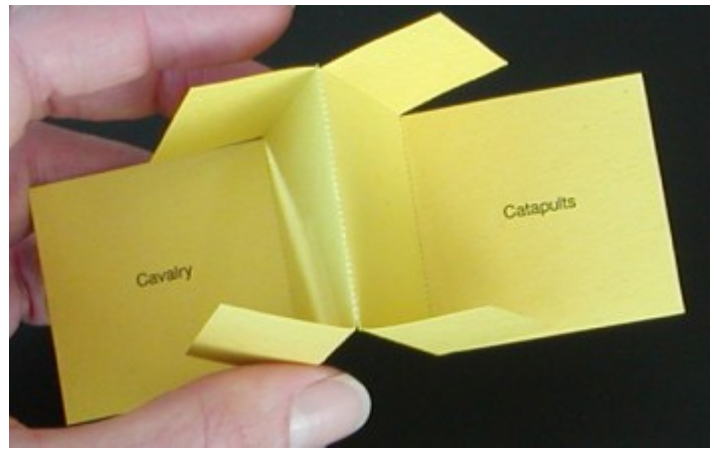
When cutting out the templates, you'll want to cut just *inside* the lines on the dividers, and maybe just *outside* the lines on the outer shell. (Yeah, I could have adjusted for the thickness of the paper in the pattern...) For the lines which go *into* the template, you probably want to cut on *both* sides, as shown here.



Start with one of the smaller divider pieces. Fold it in half,
and then fold up the flappy things...

...then fold up those *other* flappy things, so that it looks like this.

Then do the same thing with the other one.



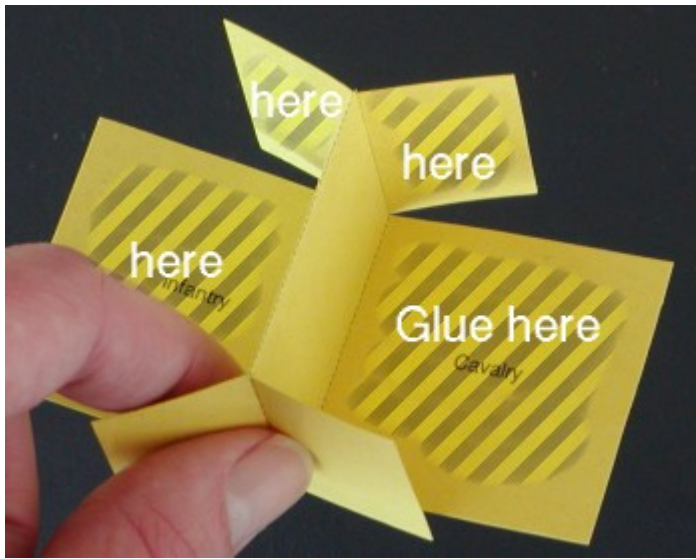
Now do the same sort of thing with the rear divider piece.

Now it's time to start gluing! Glue the middles of the two smaller pieces together, so that they look like this.



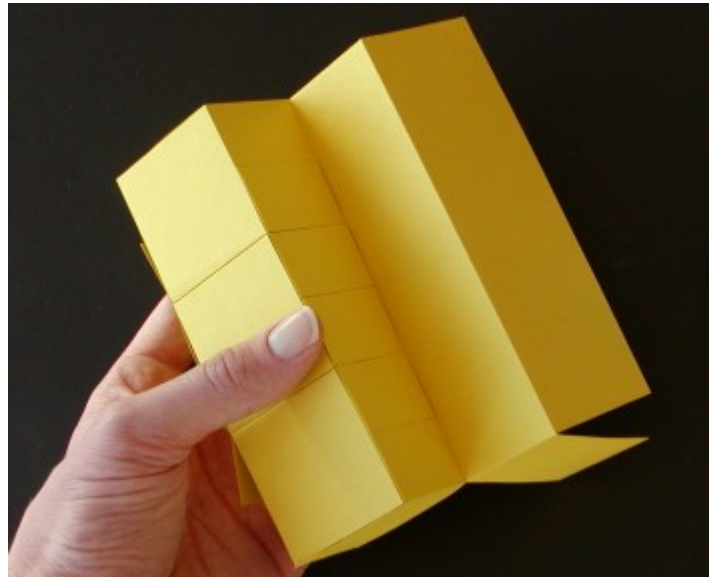
Now you're going to glue the smaller pieces onto the bigger piece. First slide one of them into place, as shown here, so that you can see how it's going to go together. Then pull them apart and apply glue.

Apply glue where shown.



After gluing both of the smaller pieces to the larger one, it should look like this.

Then flip it over and glue the vertical part together...





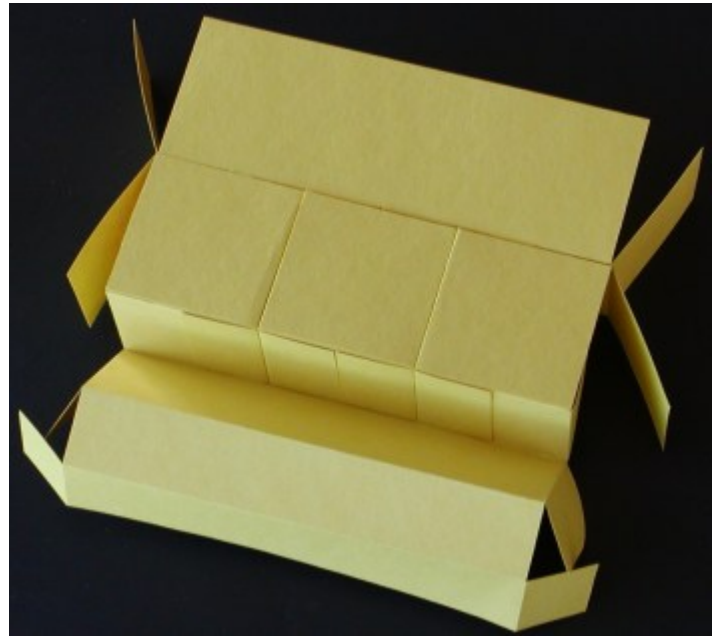
...so that it looks like this.

Now fold up the forward divider piece so that it looks like this. You're going to glue it to the rear section...



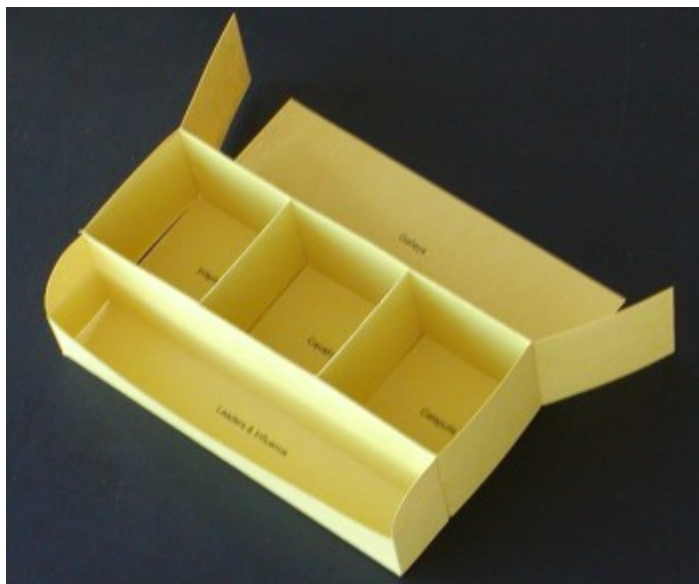
...so that it looks like this. Make sure you do a test fit first, so that you can see where to apply glue!

Now flip it over and glue the vertical part, just as you did for the rear divider.



It should look like this. Now glue those side flap things together...

...so that it looks like this.





We're almost done! It's time to attach the outer shell, which is the last piece. First, lay the divider on the shell and make sure that the fold lines are in the right place. When folding the outer shell, you may want to fold a hair *outside* the fold lines; if you fold inside, the divider section might not quite fit.

After folding the shell, glue the two together. Just do the bottom at first.



Then glue the front edge of the shell to the front edge of the divider, and the side flaps of the shell front & back to the divider sides.

Then glue the sides up... and **you're done!**
